Entry to matches

Entry to matches will be by advanced tickets (including season tickets) initially. Please do not come to Woodhorn Lane without first having purchased a ticket unless we have specifically advertised that there are "on the day sales" available.

Track & Trace

All tickets purchased online will be scanned on entry which will ensure your visit is automatically recorded for Track & Trace purposes.

Season ticket holders in attendance will be recorded against our membership database.

Any spectators attending via "on the day sales" will be required to complete a check in via the evePASS app which can be downloaded to any smartphone. A barcode will be available at the entrance to scan for this.

Good hygiene / hand sanitiser

Hand sanitiser is available throughout the building and we encourage all visitors to use this.

Toilet access

Toilets will be open on the ground floor of the building and these will be checked and cleaned regularly. Please adhere to social distancing when using these facilities and follow the one way signs to exit the building.

Access to bar / main stand

Access to the bar will be via the main internal staircase, as well as clearly marked entry doors from the main stand. There is a one way system in place upstairs in the clubhouse, with a single exit to the main stand from the bar area. We would encourage contactless payment where possible for all transactions at the bar.

Seating / stands

Certain seats in the main stand have been marked as not in use. There is a number of single and double seats available for spectators, but please adhere to social distancing guidance.

The seated stand at the far side of the ground will not be accessible for matches.
